



Member Protection Declaration

Tennis New Zealand and associated New Zealand Tennis Entities (as defined in the Tennis New Zealand Participant Protection Policy) have a duty of care to its members and to the general public who interact with employees, volunteers, members and others involved with tennis activities. As part of this duty of care and as a requirement of Tennis New Zealand’s Tennis Participant Protection Policy, Tennis New Zealand and New Zealand Tennis Entities must enquire into the background of:

- persons who are appointed or seeking appointment with children under 18 years of age and / or vulnerable persons (whether employed, contracted, volunteer or otherwise) as a coach, team manager, tournament director or umpire; and
- persons appointed or seeking appointment to a role in which they are likely to have individual and unsupervised contact with players under 18 years of age or vulnerable people
